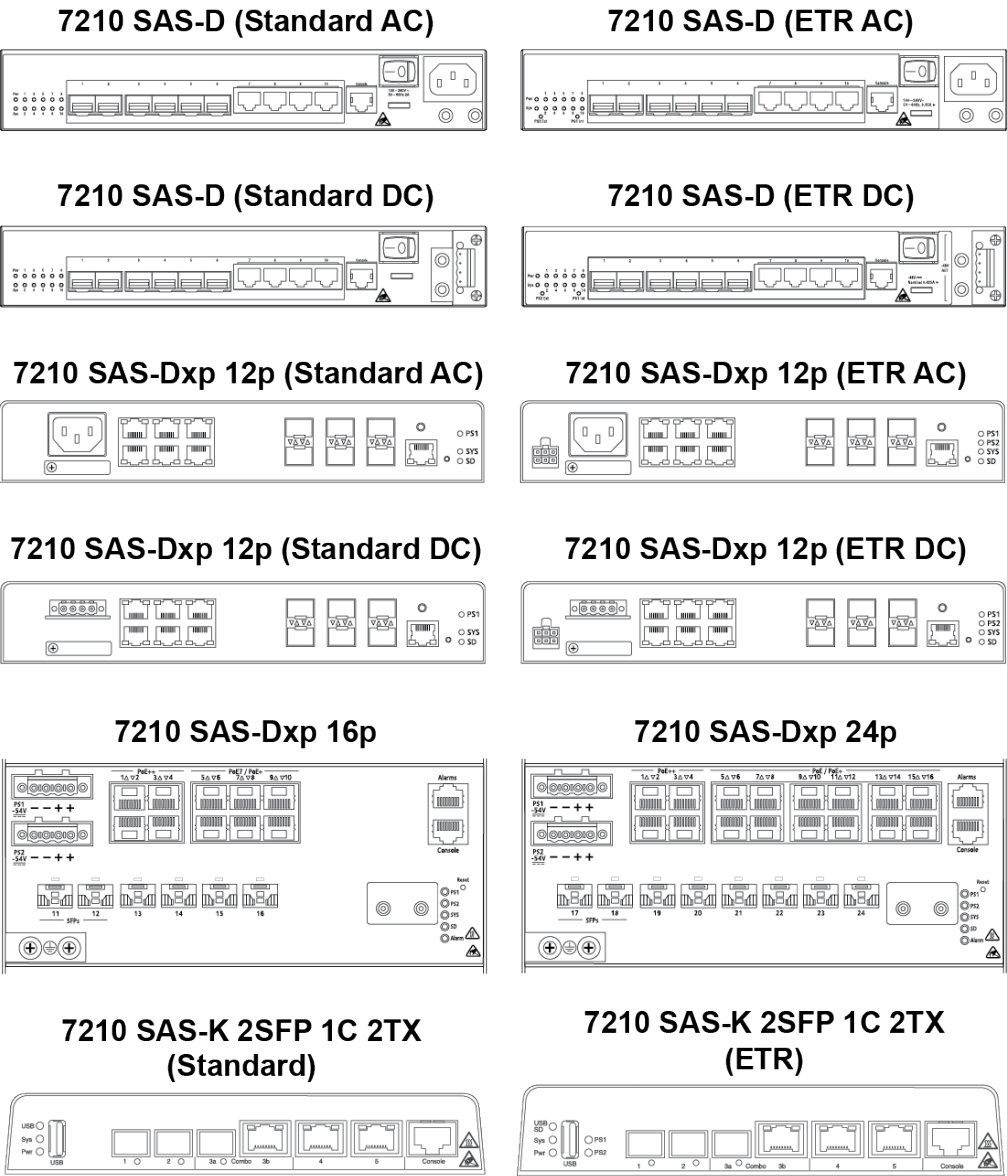

This guide provides information about the user guides available for the 7210 Service Access System (7210 SAS).

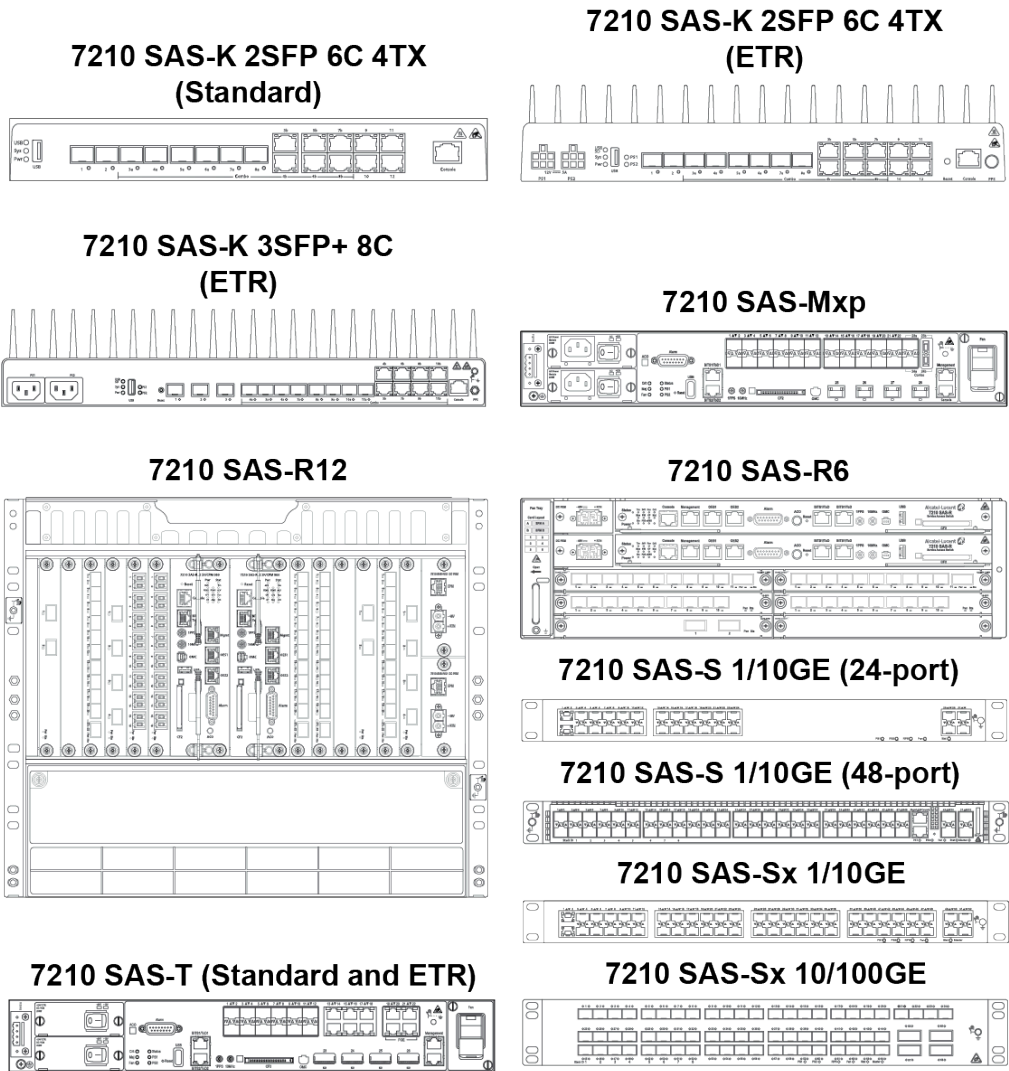
